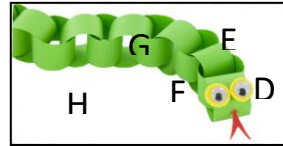


Alphabet Paper Chain Snake Craft


- ✓ Paper
- ✓ Tape, glue or stapler
- ✓ Markers

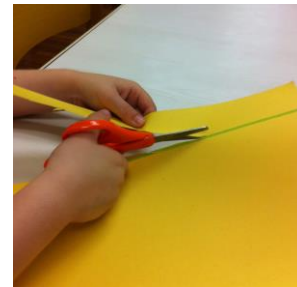
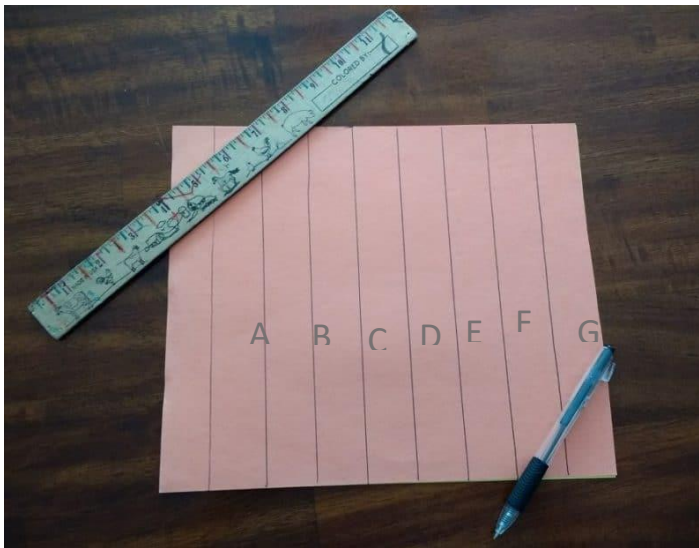


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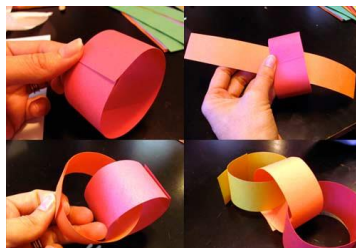
Materials Needed:

Steps:

1. Ask your kiddo what color paper they want their snake/caterpillar to be 
2. Draw straight lines equal distance apart on the paper and label each strip with a letter of the alphabet. Your child can write or trace the letters. If you want you could write numbers instead of letters



3. Help your child cut out the strips
4. Your kiddo should help you lay out the strips in order
5. Curl the paper around until the ends meet and glue, tape or staple the ends together



6. Loop the second piece through the first and curl that one around so the ends meet
7. Glue, tape or staple the ends together
8. Repeat the process until all the letter of the alphabet become part of your creatures body
9. Draw eyes or cut out a tongue, eyes and antennae if you want and attach them to the head
