

## Father's Day Award Craft



### **Materials Needed:**

1. Glue Stick
2. Construction Paper – Any Color
3. Markers – Any Color (dark colors will be easily seen over paint)
4. Paints/Paint Brush – Any Color
5. Scissors
6. Decorations (Stickers/Glitter/PomPoms/Etc)
7. Paper Plate

### **Steps:**

1. Have white paper plate facing up (how it would regularly be when using it)



2. Paint entire front of paper plate and let dry.



3. Write/Trace/Hand-Over-Hand written message (best dad award, happy father's day, number 1 dad, best dad, etc)



4. Decorate! (Use Stickers/Glitter/PomPoms/Etc)



5. Cut out two strips of construction paper for "Ribbon" (modified- have these strips already cut out and ready to glue)
  - a. Cut one triangle at one end of each strip



6. Glue straight end of "Ribbon" strips to back to plate, make sure to let them hang over to be seen in the front!



7. All Done! Give to dad!
