

Make a Lady Bug



Materials Needed:

- ✓ Glue
- √ Googly eyes (or painted eyes)
- ✓ Red construction paper or fabric
- ✓ Black construction paper or fabric
- √ Scissors (preferably zigzag scissors)

Steps:

1. Fold a red piece of red construction paper in half and draw a half circle with the center being

the fold.



2. Cut along the line then unfold to show full circle. This will be the ladybug's body.





3. Cut a smaller circle from black paper or fabric to make the ladybug's head and glue head on.



4. Glue two googley eyes to the head.



5. Make antennas. Cut two small, thin rectangles from the black paper or fabric and glue them to the top of the head.





7. Cut another slim rectangle line. Glue it to the center of the red circle.



8. Create 'spots'. Cut (6) small-sized circles from the black paper or fabric and glue on body
