

Flower Pot



Materials Needed:

- ✓ Pink paper (optional: can use another color if you want)
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Green paint
- ✓ Paint brush
- ✓ Cup
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Yellow pompom
- ✓ Plastic spoon

Steps:


1. Take a piece of pink paper and fold it in half.



2. Fold it into thirds by folding one side to the middle and the other side to the middle. It should look like a square.



3. Use a pencil to draw a tear drop shape.



4. Cut along the line. This will give you your flower petals.




5. Apply glue to the front of your spoon.



6. Place one flower petal on the center of the spoon at a time. Add more glue and place another flower petal. Repeat this step until all of the petals are secured.



7. Glue the yellow pompom in the middle.



8. Turn your cup upside down and make a small slit in the middle using your scissors.



9. Paint your cup green with a paintbrush.



10. Put the handle of the spoon in the hole and paint it green.





Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Shape identification – what shapes do you see?
- Color identification – what colors did you use?
- 1:1 counting – how many petals does the flower have?
