

Handprint Sun Craft



Materials Needed:

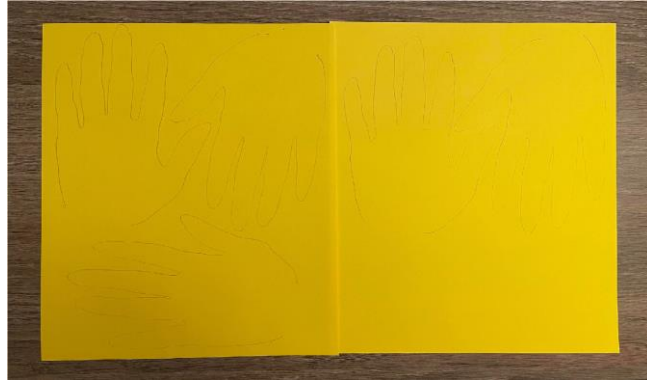
- ✓ Paper plate
- ✓ Yellow paint
- ✓ Yellow and orange paper
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Scissors

Steps:

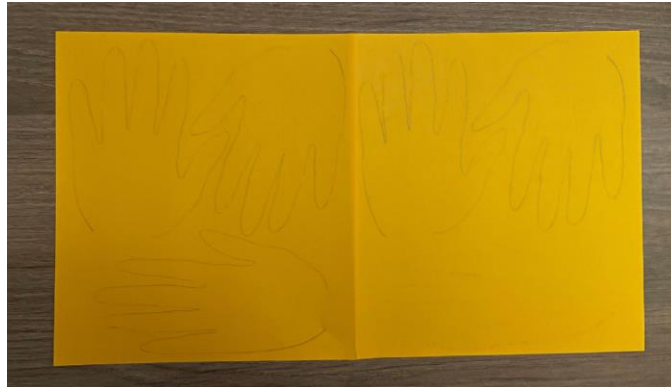
1. Paint the back of a paper plate yellow. Set it aside until it is completely dry.



- Put your hand on a piece of yellow construction paper and carefully trace around each finger. Ask an adult for help tracing your hand if you need to! You should trace your hand 5 times.



- Repeat step 2 on orange paper.



- Cut out each handprint. You should have 10 altogether.



5. Once the paper plate is dry, add a small amount of glue to the bottom of a handprint and attach to the edge of the plate.



6. Repeat until all of your handprints are glued onto the plate.



7. Add a fun face to your sun with a marker!
