

Toilet Paper Roll Butterfly



Materials Needed:

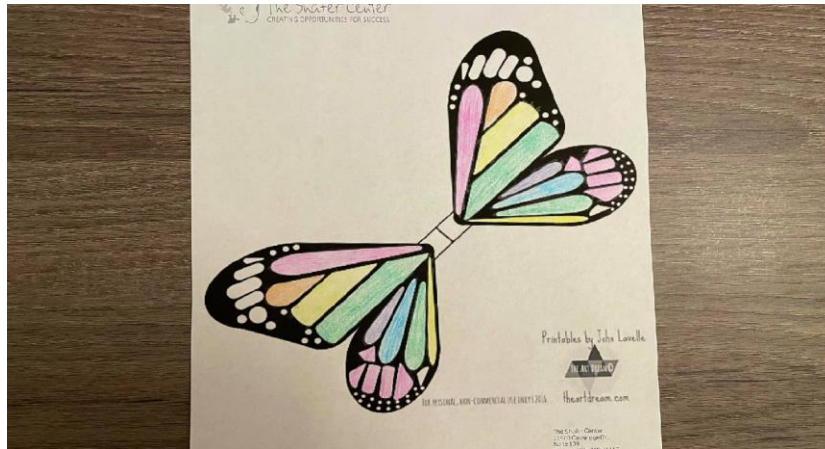
- ✓ Toilet paper roll
- ✓ Printed wing and body templates (found below)
- ✓ Colored markers
- ✓ White paper
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue

Steps:

1. Color the butterfly body template with markers.



2. Color the wings.



3. Carefully cut out the body and wing templates. Make sure to separate the wings by cutting along the grey line in the middle!



4. Flip the body template over and put a line of glue on the left and right edges. Attach the body template to the toilet paper roll by securing one glued edge to the toilet paper roll and wrapping the rest tightly around the roll. It is okay if part of the template overlaps!



5. Fold the small tab on each wing, and apply a small amount of glue.



6. Attach the wings along the grey lines of the butterfly's body.



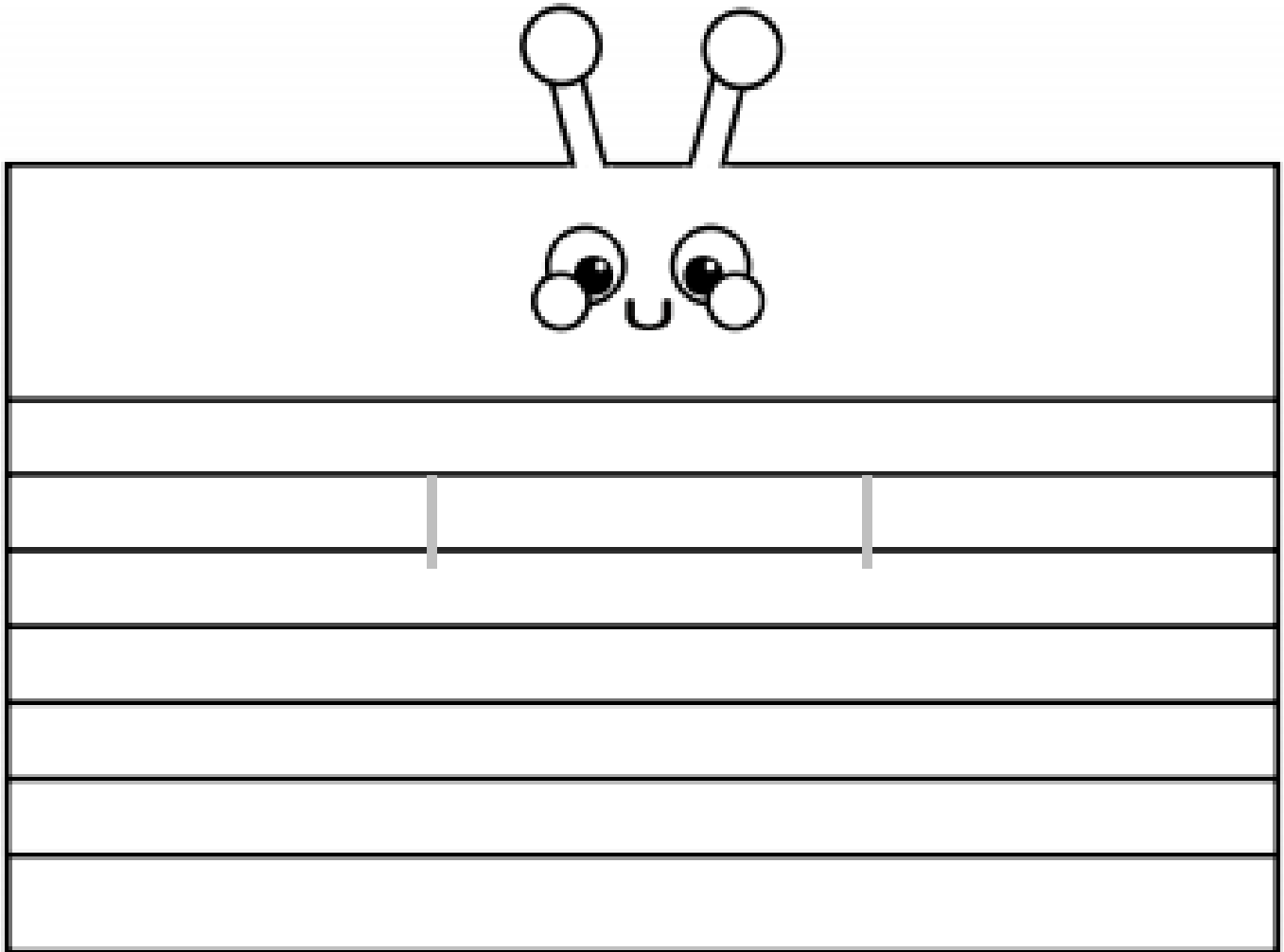
Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Imaginative play – make the butterfly fly around the room
- Color identification – what colors did you use?
- Imitation – move your body like a caterpillar, a chrysalis, and a butterfly and have your child follow along
- Counting – how many stripes does the butterfly have?

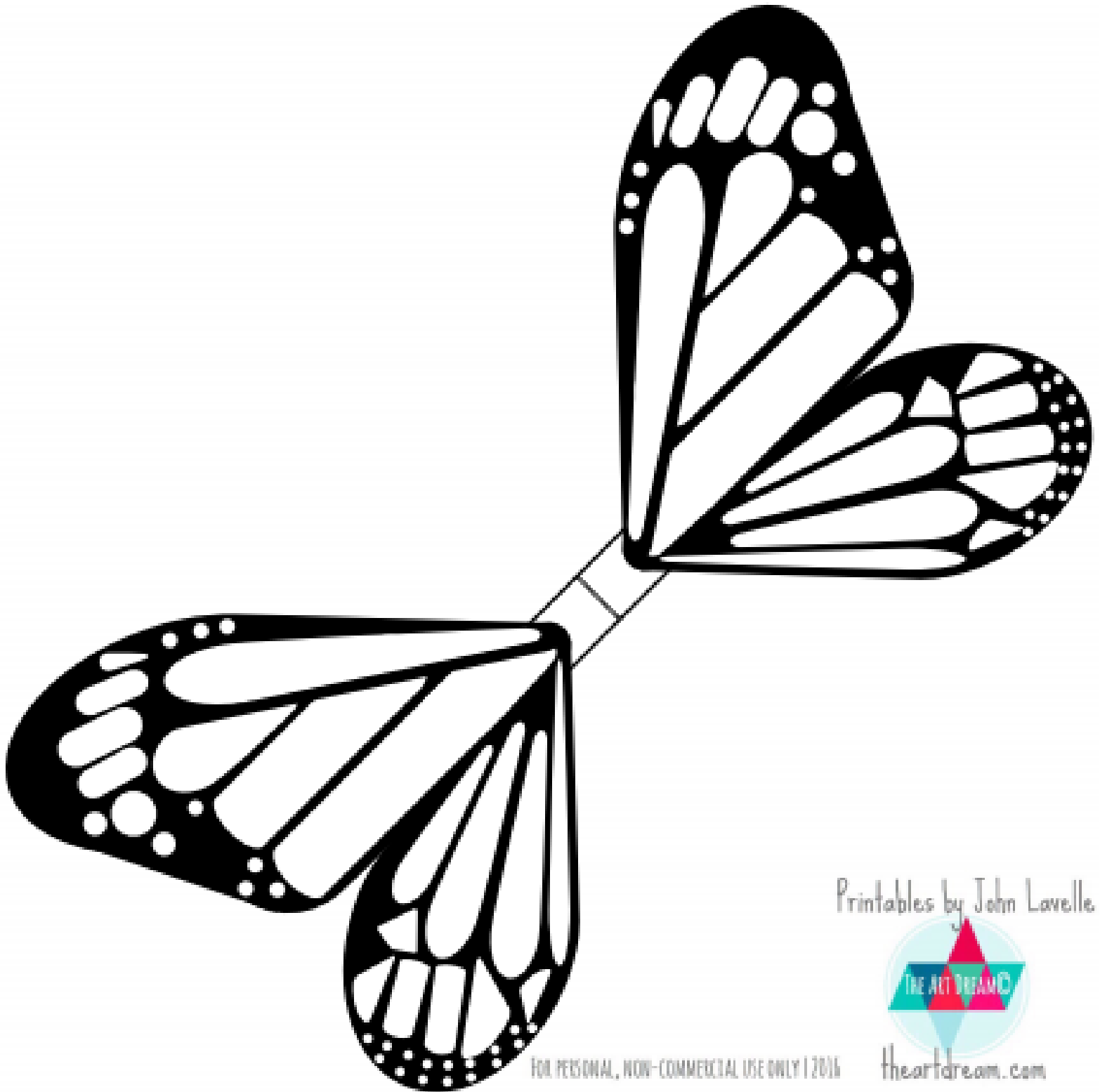


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
