

Bumble Bee

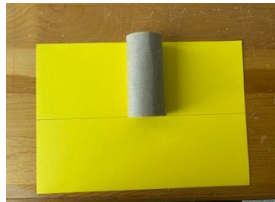


Materials Needed:

- ✓ Toilet paper roll
- ✓ 1 piece of yellow construction paper
- ✓ 1 piece of black construction paper
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Markers
- ✓ Googly eyes (optional)

Steps:

1. Wrap the yellow construction paper around the toilet paper roll to measure



2. Cut the paper so that it fits the size of the toilet paper roll (modified- precut the paper for them to glue)



3. Glue the construction paper to the toilet paper roll



4. Cut 2 stripes out of black construction paper (modified- precut the paper for them to glue)



5. Wrap 1 stripe around the toilet paper roll to measure
6. Cut the stripe to fit around the toilet paper roll
7. Glue



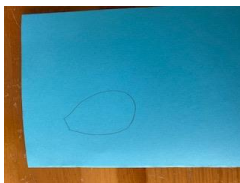
8. Repeat x1 steps 5-7
9. Use black marker to draw 2 eyes OR Glue 2 googly eyes on the front (if applicable)



10. Use a marker to draw a mouth under the eyes



11. Draw two oval shapes for the wings on any color paper



12. Cut out 2 oval shapes



13. Glue both ovals on the back of the toilet paper roll for wings



14. Cut 2 small rectangles out of black construction paper



15. Glue 2 small rectangles on the top of the toilet paper roll for antennas



Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Make "buzzing" sounds like a bee, "What does the bee say?"
- Count the stripes
- Talk about the pattern (yellow, black, yellow, black)



- Identify the colors on a bee
- Play skills- Hold the bee in the air and make it fly like a bee
