

Lady Bug



Materials Needed:

- ✓ Red and black paper (and just a little bit of white)
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Black marker

Steps:

- 1. Cut a circle out of red paper
- 2. Cut about 10 strips of red paper



- 3. Cut out 10 (about) small dots from black paper
- 4. Cut a half circle of black paper for the face
- 5. Cut 2 small pieces of black paper for antennas
- 6. Cut out 2 small white circles (modified- precut the pieces of paper)
- 7. Draw 2 black dots inside the white circles for eyes





8. Take 1 strip of red paper and glue the ends to the red circle



9. Take another strip of red paper and glue the ends to other side of the red circle



10. Repeat x8 (or as desired to make the lady bug more full)



- 11. Glue the eyes onto the face
- 12. Glue both antennas to the top of the face





- 13. Glue the face to the body
- 14. Glue black dots to the body



Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Count the dots on the lady bug
- Color labeling, point and ask "what color?" OR ask them to touch a color
