

Texture Collage

Materials Needed:

- √ Household items with texture (ex. old piece of fabric, sponge, comb, pile of rubber bands)
- ✓ Crayons
- ✓ At least 2 Blank sheets of paper (any color)
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ shape stencils, the bottom of other household items to create a shape, or make your own

Steps:

1. Gather materials needed



2. Place textured items under a blank sheet of paper. Avoid overlapping




*Feel free to travel with the paper to find more exciting textures in your home.



3. Begin to color over your textures with crayons






4. Place shape stencil on paper and trace



5. Cut and Paste









6. Add all your texture shapes to your second blank sheet of paper and trace the shape. Making your own cool design.
