


Alphabet Paper Chain Snake Craft

- ✓ Paper
- √ Tape, glue or stapler
- ✓ Markers



Materials Needed:

Steps:

- 1. Ask your kiddo what color paper they want their snake/caterpillar to be
- 2. Draw straight lines equal distance apart on the paper and label each strip with a letter of the alphabet. Your child can write or trace the letters. If you want you could write numbers instead of letters





- 3. Help your child cut out the strips
- 4. Your kiddo should help you lay out the strips in order
- 5. Curl the paper around until the ends meet and glue, tape or staple the ends together





- 6. Loop the second piece through the first and curl that one around so the ends meet
- 7. Glue, tape or staple the ends together
- 8. Repeat the process until all the letter of the alphabet become part of your creatures body
- 9. Draw eyes or cut out a tongue, eyes and antennae if you want and attach them to the head
