

DIY Maraca

Materials Needed:

- ✓ 2 plastic spoons
- √ Tape (can be lots of different colors)
- ✓ Tiny objects such as beads, uncooked rice, or uncooked beans
- ✓ Plastic egg

Steps:

- 1. Fill your plastic egg with the tiny objects of your choice.
- 2. Place the two spoons together with the two heads of the spoons facing each other.
- 3. Wrap the tape tightly around the spoon handles.
- 4. Gently open the heads of the spoons and put the plastic egg inside.
- 5. Wrap tape around the spoons and eggs. Tape over it multiple times to make sure it is secure. If you used plain tape, you can decorate the tape with markers.
- 6. Shake, shake, shake!!



Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Picking up the tiny pieces of beans or rice is an excellent fine motor activity. Help your child practice picking up the tiny objects one by one.
- Have your child practice counting as they are putting the small objects into the egg.
- Practice naming colors if you are using colorful spoons, eggs, or tape.
- Have your child practice asking for specific colors of objects if you are using colorful materials.
 (Ex: Can I have the blue spoon? Can I have the orange egg? I want the yellow tape, etc)
