

Shape Monsters

Materials Needed:

- ✓ Construction Paper
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue Stick



Steps:



1. Pick one or more shapes to use as the monsters body. Some shapes to choose from are square, oval, rectangle, heart, circle and pentagon. They should be almost the size of the piece of construction paper to allow you to have enough space to glue everything on.

2. Next cut shapes for the features in different colors.



3. Cut 10 medium sized white circles and 10 small sized black circles. These circles will be for the monsters' eyes. You can use other colors if you would like.



4. These next shapes can be any color. 6 semi-circles for mouths, 6 triangles for noses, squares for teeth (any amount), and 24 medium sized rectangles for arms & legs (optional).



5. Allow your child to glue the features onto each shape of the monster's body.
