

Candle Light



Materials Needed:

- ✓ Construction paper in red, black, yellow, and green (feel free to choose other colors)
- ✓ Tape/glue
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Red marker

Steps:

1. Cut out a long rectangular shape using the red construction paper. This will be the base of your candle. Glue red rectangular piece in the center of your black construction paper.



- Using the yellow construction paper, have an adult in your house trace the shape of a flame. Cut out the flame and glue it to the top of your candle. **Optional: cut out a smaller flame in orange and glue it in the center of your flame.**



- Cut or tear pieces of the green construction paper in different shapes and sizes. These will be the evergreen leaves for the bottom of the candle. Once a bunch of leaves have been cut or torn, glue them to the bottom of the candle.



- Lastly, using your red marker, draw little red circles throughout the leaves. These red circles will act as your berries and will complete your candle!
