

## **Handy Dandy Polar Bear**



## **Materials Needed:**

- ✓ A white sheet of paper
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Pink marker
- ✓ Black marker
- ✓ Tape/glue
- √ Scissors
- ✓ **Optional:** Blue and Light Blue Cardstock
- ✓ Optional: Foam snowflake stickers
- ✓ Polar bear handprint template (at the bottom of the template)

## Steps:

1. With help or on your own, trace your hand on a white sheet of paper.

2. Using the print out at the bottom of the document, cut and glue the polar bear's head onto the thumb.



3. Use the pink marker to draw in the polar bear's inner ear and cheeks.



4. Use the black marker to draw the claws onto the bottom of the polar bear's feet.



5. Use the optional blue card stock or crayons and markers to create your polar bear scene with icebergs.





6. Place glue along the back of the polar bear handprint and glue it onto the large iceberg. Place the foam snowflake stickers all around the paper for decoration.
