

Make a Bolang Gu



Materials Needed:

- ✓ 2 biodegradable paper plates
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Acrylic paint
- ✓ Paint brush
- ✓ String
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Wood beads
- ✓ Wood chopstick or tree branch stick

Steps:

1. Draw Taegeuk outline on back of one paper plate and paint each part of the symbol with red, blue, and then yellow.

2. Glue the wooden chopstick to the inside of one of the plates



3. Glue both plates together with chopstick in the middle and a piece of string on each side of paper plate.





4. Thread beads at end of each string and tie a knot for the beads to stay
