

Bouquet of Flowers



Materials Needed:

- √ Green paper (for grass)
- √ White/ pink/ red/ yellow paper (for flowers)
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue

Steps:

1. Fold your green paper hotdog style and make vertical cuts down the folded side.





2. Roll the paper with the uncut edges facing down and glue to secure.



- 3. Draw petal shapes and small circles on your colored paper. You should have a matching number of flowers and circles. Use at least two different colors so you can mix and match!
- 4. Cut out each shape. Glue one circle on each flower shape.



5. Glue your flowers to the ends of the green paper.





Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- 1:1 counting how many flowers are there?
- Color identification what colors are your flowers?
- Shape identification do you know any shapes on the flowers? How about on the grass?
- Yes/no questions "Are these flowers real?", "Do we need to water them?"
