

Bouquet of Flowers



Materials Needed:

- ✓ Green paper (for grass)
- ✓ White/ pink/ red/ yellow paper (for flowers)
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue

Steps:

1. Fold your green paper hotdog style and make vertical cuts down the folded side.



2. Roll the paper with the uncut edges facing down and glue to secure.



3. Draw petal shapes and small circles on your colored paper. You should have a matching number of flowers and circles. Use at least two different colors so you can mix and match!
4. Cut out each shape. Glue one circle on each flower shape.



5. Glue your flowers to the ends of the green paper.





Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- 1:1 counting – how many flowers are there?
- Color identification – what colors are your flowers?
- Shape identification – do you know any shapes on the flowers? How about on the grass?
- Yes/no questions – “Are these flowers real?”, “Do we need to water them?”
