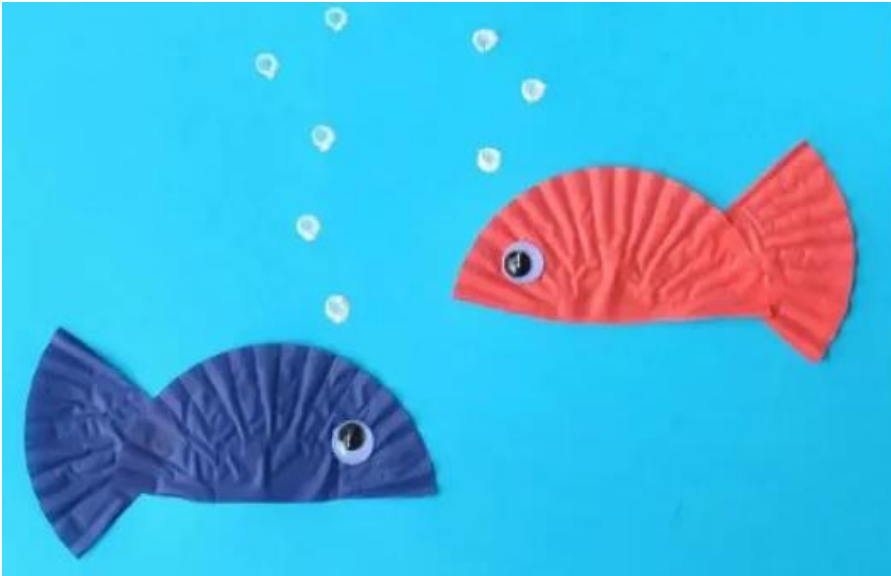


Red Fish Blue Fish



Materials Needed:

- ✓ Blue paper
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Red and blue mini cupcake liners
- ✓ Cotton swab
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ White paint
- ✓ Googly eyes

Steps:

1. Fold a blue mini cupcake liner in half and cut along the fold to form the body of the fish.



2. Fold one of the halves in half again and cut along that fold to form the fish's tail.



3. Glue the tail to a piece of blue paper.



4. Glue body slightly covering the tip of the tail to make the whole fish and glue on one eye.



5. Repeat steps 1-4 with a red cupcake liner to create your red fish.

6. To make the air bubbles for the fish, you can use a cotton swab dipped in white paint.



6. Use the cotton swab to make dots (bubbles) on your blue paper.



Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Color identification – what color are your fish?
- 1:1 counting – how many fish are swimming? How many bubbles did they blow?
- WH questions – where do fish live?
- Imitation – make a fish face and have your kiddo imitate you.
