

## Rocket Ship



### Materials Needed:

- ✓ Green, red, yellow, blue, and white paper
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Tape
- ✓ Glue

### Steps:

1. Take a green piece of paper, roll it like a tube, and tape it.



2. Draw a medium sized circle on a red piece of paper and cut it out.



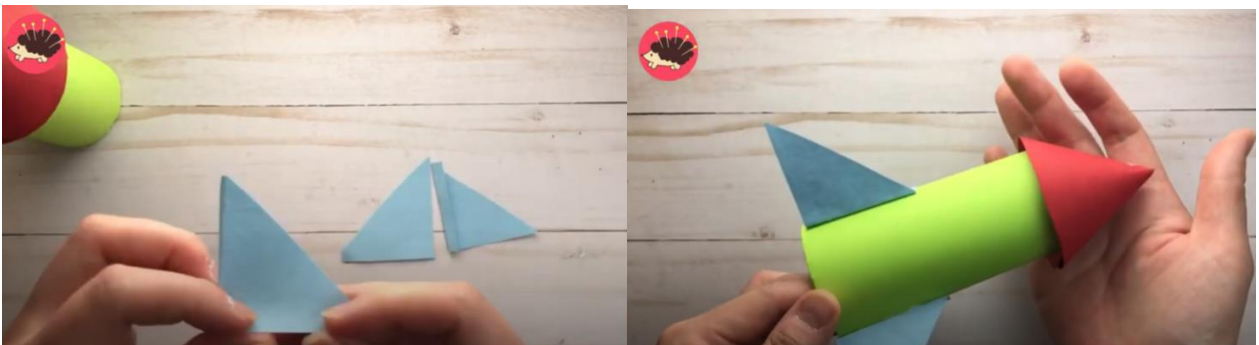
3. Cut a triangle out of the circle (it will look like Pacman). Tape one end so that it overlaps with the other side. It will make a cone.



4. Put glue on top of the green tube and place the red cone on top.



5. Cut out three blue triangles and fold one of the shorter sides on each. Glue them around the bottom of the green tube to make the wings of the rocket ship.



6. Cut out three small, white circles and glue them on the rocket ship in a straight line.



7. Cut out three small rectangles from the yellow paper. Cut slits to the center of the yellow paper and attach them inside the bottom of the rocket ship to make it look like fire.



### **Additional Skill Practice:**

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Intraverbal fill-in – count down from 3 and have your kiddo respond with “blast off!”
- Imaginative play – fly your rocket ship around the room! What sounds do you think it would make?
- 1:1 correspondence – how many wings does the rocket have? How many windows?
