

Flower Crown




Materials Needed:

- ✓ Green paper
- ✓ Ruler
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Tape

Steps:


1. Use your ruler to measure 3 inches from the long edge of your green paper and draw a line. Repeat this one more time measuring from the line you just drew.





2. Cut out both sections so that you have two long rectangles.



3. Tape the short ends together to make one long strip.



4. Wrap the green strip around the top of your head to measure how big your crown needs to be. Once it is tight enough to stay on your head comfortably, tape the outside edge down so that it stays circular when you take it off.

5. Tape the flowers that you picked all around the outside of the crown. The more flowers, the better!



Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Categories what category would a crown belong in? (options food, furniture, clothing, etc.)
- Prepositions Are the flowers under, around, or next to the crown?
- Labeling point to the flower petals, the stem, and the crown.
