

## Handprint Flower



### **Materials Needed:**

- ✓ Colored paper
- ✓ Green paper
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue or tape
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Disposable straw

### **Steps:**

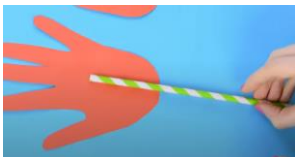
1. Trace a hand on preferred colored paper.



2. Cut out traced handprint with scissors.



3. Tape or glue the tip of the disposable straw to one side of the handprint.



4. Draw and cut out a leaf shape on the green paper. A simple leaf shape can be a triangle or diamond!



5. Last, tape or glue one end of leaf to the middle of the stem (straw). You can give your flower more than one leaf if you would like!



### **Additional Skill Practice:**

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Count – how many pedals and leaves does your flower have?
- Color identification – what colors are your flowers?
- Imaginative play – pretend to plant your flowers, pick them and put them in a vase to display!
