

## Paper Bee



## Materials Needed:

- $\checkmark$  Yellow and black paint
- ✓ Paint brush
- $\checkmark~$  White, black, and yellow paper
- ✓ Glue or tape
- ✓ Black marker
- ✓ Scissors

## <u>Steps:</u>

1. Roll yellow paper into tube, gluing or taping down the ends together. Let dry if used glue. This will be the bee body.



2. Paint black stripes onto yellow tube.



3. Fold white paper in half, draw one wing shape (a 3 shape), and cut. Unfold to reveal mirrored wings.

4. Cut a circle out of yellow paper for the head.



5. Cut small rectangles out of black paper for antennae.



6. Glue or tape wings to one side of bee body.



7. Draw a face on the yellow circle (bee head).



8. Glue or tape both antennae to back of bee head.



7. Glue or tape head onto bee body.
