

Paper Evergreen



Materials Needed:

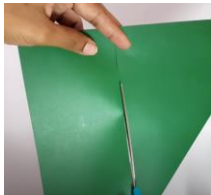
- ✓ Green paper
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Scissors

Steps:

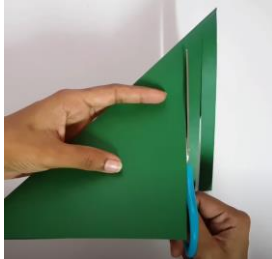
1. Fold your green paper accordingly to make into a large triangle.



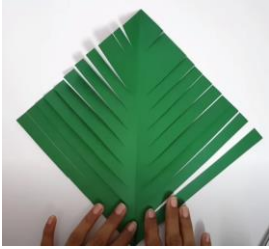
2. Cut off excess paper not included in square.



3. While still folded, cut strips up the triangle. Make sure not to cut all the way through.



4. Unfold square.



5. Apply glue to ends of top two sides of square (ends that are cut).



6. Starting at the bottom, take top end of each strip and press into center. (You may have to hold each piece for a few seconds for glue to stick and dry slightly)



7. Do this for each strip, alternating sides.



8. Work your way to the top. Leave the last middle piece at top unfolded.





Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Count – how many rows of branches does your tree have?
- Measure – use a ruler to measure how tall your tree is!
- Additional decoration – add decorations like flowers or drawn birds to your tree!
