

Paper Plate Ring Toss



Materials Needed:

- ✓ No. 2 Pencil
- ✓ Washable Paint
- ✓ Paper Towel Roll
- ✓ Clear Tape
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Paint Brush
- ✓ Paper Plates

Steps:

1. Stand paper towel roll upright in middle of plate. Trace circle outline with pencil.



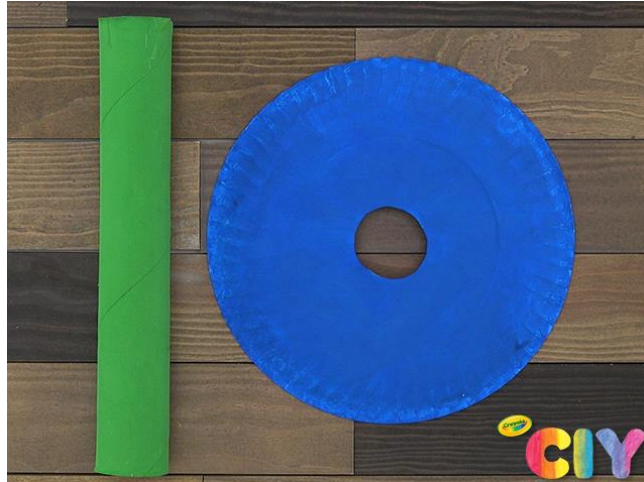
2. Cut out circle, creating small hole in plate.



3. Paint paper towel roll and set aside until dry.



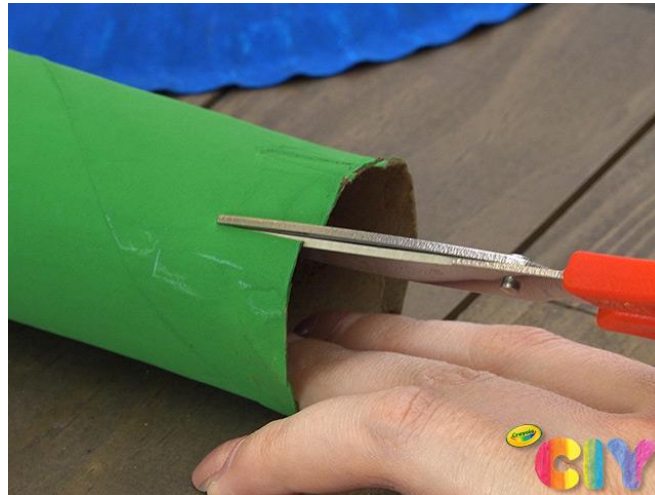
4. Flip paper plate and paint the bottom. Set aside until dry.



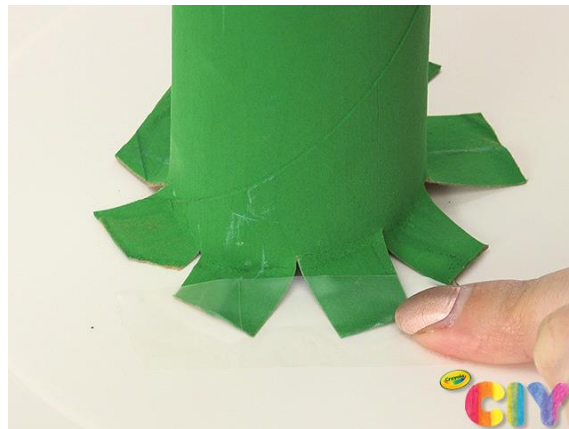
5. Cut large holes in 4–5 additional paper plates and paint. Set aside until dry.



6. Once dry, cut small slits in bottom of paper towel roll, approximately 1" apart.



7. Lightly fan out slits and tape down in middle of new paper plate.



8. Slide the paper towel roll through the hole of the painted paper plate to complete ring toss base.



Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Measurement – what is the height of your pole?
- Color Identification – what colors are the rings?
- Shapes – what shape are the rings?
- Hand Eye Coordination – throwing the rings at the target
