

Best Dad Ribbon



Materials Needed:

- ✓ Orange paper (you can swap this color for whatever color your dad/adult likes best)
- ✓ Yellow paper
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Marker


Steps:

1. Fold your orange paper in half and cut along the line to create two even rectangles.







2. Accordion fold both strips of paper.



3. Push one "accordion" together and fold in half.



4. Put glue on the inside edge of the fold and glue to the other inside edge. This will create a "fan" shape.





5. Repeat steps #3-4 with the other strip of paper.



6. Glue the two "fans" together along the flat sides to make a circle.



7. Cut out a yellow circle that is smaller than the size of your ribbon. Write what the award is for. (You can say "Best Dad Award", "Coolest Grown Up", or anything else).





8. Glue the yellow circle onto the front of the ribbon.



With your second piece of orange paper, cut two long strips. Make a V cut at the bottom of each.



10. Glue the strips to the back of your ribbon.





Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Social skills deliver your award to your chosen person and practice telling them "thank you" for all they do for you.
- Reading practice reading the name of your award.
- Shape identification what shapes do you see on your award?
