

Clothespin Fairies



Materials Needed:

- ✓ Round peg clothespin
- ✓ Tulle
- ✓ Markers
- ✓ Yarn
- ✓ Glue
- √ Washi Tape (colorful tape)

Steps:

1. To make a fairy in a dress: place two small, round tulle pieces together and cut a tiny hole in the center. Place the clothespin inside





2. Wrap the clothespin with washi tape along the edge of the tulle to ensure the skirt stays put.



3. Now cut a few yarn pieces and glue them on the back of the fairy's head. Then add two eyes and a smile.



4. To make a fairy in a cape: fold a corner of tulle (the cape) behind the clothespin head and tape it down. Continue to wrap the washi tape around the body until the torso is covered. Add yarn hair, two eyes, and a smile to complete the look.





Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Movement help your fairies fly, dance, and twirl around the room.
- Imaginative play take the fairies on an adventure! You can take them outside, host a tea party, or just practice saying hello!
- Social skills introduce yourself to your fairy friends. You can start by saying hello, telling them your name, and asking what their name is.
