

Marble Coaster



Materials Needed:

- ✓ Toilet paper rolls
- ✓ Paper towel rolls
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Tape
- ✓ Marble

Steps:

1. Cut several toilet paper tubes in half.



2. Stand up your paper towel roll and tape it to the table. Attach two of your cut tubes to your paper towel roll 'tower'.



3. Tape two toilet paper tubes together to make a smaller tower and attach it to the table and the roller coaster.



4. Stand up one toilet paper tube and attach to table, and use your remaining coaster pieces to connect all three of your 'towers'. You might need to put some smaller pieces of coaster ramp to keep the marble from falling off corners. Adjust as needed.



Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Functional play – try redesigning your coaster! Can you make it taller? How about longer?
- Describing words – is your coaster tall or short? Does the marble go fast or slow?
- Counting – how many times can your marble go down the coaster without falling off the side?
