

Paper Plate Doughnut



Materials Needed:

- ✓ Paper plate
- ✓ Paint (brown/tan and variety of colors)
- ✓ Paint brush
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Sealable bag(s)
- ✓ Uncooked white rice
- ✓ Food dye

<u>Steps:</u>

1. Place ¼ cup uncooked white rice in a bag with one or two drops of food coloring. Mix and set aside open to dry. Use these as doughnut sprinkles! You can make multiple colored sprinkles if you would like!



2. Fold paper plate in half and cut out the center of the paper plate.

3. Paint rim tan/light brown. Let dry.



4. Use your preferred colored of paint to paint icing! Paint the inside of the rim of your doughnut. Let dry.



5. Add glue



6. Add your "sprinkles" to glue. Let dry.
