

## Wacky Tacky Hair Wig

### **Materials Needed:**

- ✓ Grocery bag
- ✓ Tape
- ✓ Rainbow crepe Paper Streamers
- ✓ Scissors

### **Steps:**

1. Put the plastic bag on the top of your child's head along their hairline. Do not cover their eyes or face. Roll the bag by the base of the neck so it becomes tight around their head and secure it by tying a knot or using tape. Tuck in any loose ends and tape a long strip around the edge of the cap.



2. Cut strips of rainbow crepe paper (we used 50 strips) to desired length and tape them to the plastic cap. To hide the tape on the very top of the wig I folded the crepe paper in half, and then taped the underside of the streamer onto the top of the wig.





### **Additional Skill Practice:**

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Colors Identification - identify the colors of your wig.
- Pretend Play – try giving your wig a new style! You can try braiding, creating pigtails, or add clips for decoration.
- 1:1 Counting – how many streamers did it take to make a wig? Let's count.
