

Binoculars

Materials Needed:

- ✓ 2 toilet paper roles
- ✓ String, ribbon or yarn
- ✓ Glue or tape
- ✓ Scissors
- \checkmark Hand hole puncher or a pencil
- ✓ Paint/markers or stickers-optional




Steps:

1. Optional: have the kids paint or color the two toilet paper roles



- 2. Poke a hole through each toilet paper roll
- 3. Cut the ribbon to the desired length
- 4. Next string it through both the holes



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- 5. Tie the ends to keep it in place
- 6. Tape or glue the two toilet paper rolls together to keep them in place



7. Can add stickers or whatever design you want



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8. All done! Go out and go explore



Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Asking "what color is it?" for the paint or markers if used
- Ask "What do you see?" when the child is looking at items
- Make a game out of it and play "I Spy" with the binoculars

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
