



Handprint Pete the Cat

Materials Needed:

- ✓ Blue washable paint
- ✓ Paper (blue, red, and white)
- ✓ Marker
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue

Steps:

1. Cut out a cat head/face out of the blue paper.



Paint your whole hand blue. You may use gloves if you do not like messy hands.



- 3. Place your painted hand down on the white piece of paper.
- 4. Cut out 4 red rectangles for the shoes. Glue them on onto the handprint of your four fingers.
- 5. Cut out a small red triangle for the nose. Glue it on the center of the face.
- 6. Cut out 2 small circles for the eyes. Glue onto the face.
- 7. Use the marker to draw whiskers and other details like laces.
- 8. Hang up to dry!





Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Practice prepositions when giving directions. (ex, Glue eyes above the nose. Glue shoes under.)
- Work on naming the shapes you are cutting out.
- Work on naming the colors of the papers and materials you are using.
- Practice labeling the materials being used. (Ask "What is it?" while holding up the glue stick.)
- Practice receptive commands. (Examples: "Give me glue.")
