

Popsicle Craft

Materials Needed:

- ✓ Card stock
- ✓ Black marker
- ✓ Colorful pieces of tissue paper cut into squares
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Popsicle stick
- ✓ Paintbrush
- ✓ Bowl of glue

Steps:

1. Use a marker to draw a popsicle shape onto the card stock.

2. Use the paintbrush to spread the glue on the popsicle shape. Add the squares of tissue paper onto the gluey area.

3. When it is dry, cut out the popsicle and glue the popsicle stick onto the back.

Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Have your child practice cutting along the lines to cut the squares of tissue paper or the popsicle.
- Your child can practice identifying colors of the tissue paper when they are requesting. (Ex: Can I have the blue square? Can I have a yellow square?)
- Practice fine motor skills by picking up the tissue paper squares one at a time.
