

Frosty the Snowman mask:

Materials Needed:

- ✓ Paper plate
- ✓ Black construction paper (1 piece)
- ✓ Red construction paper (1 piece)
- ✓ Popsicle Stick
- ✓ Markers
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue



Steps:

1. Cut one piece of black construction paper along its long side. It should be ~ 2 inches thick
2. Place the remaining paper lengthwise, and glue the long strip on the short end of the paper.
3. Trim the brim of the hat if your strip is too long.
4. Place the red construction paper on the short end of your hat
5. Use a marker to mark how long your strip needs to be so that it is the same length as the hat.
You can make your red ribbon as thin or thick as you like!
6. Cut out your red strip
7. Glue the red strip above the black strip
8. Use scissors to cut out the center of a paper plate
9. Glue your hat on the top of the paper plate.
10. Turn the Frosty mask over
11. Glue a popsicle stick the bottom of the mask
12. Decorate! Use markers to decorate your new magic hat however you like!

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:
