

Hanukkah Paper Plate Menorahs:



Materials Needed:

- ✓ Paper plate
- ✓ Construction paper (white and orange/yellow)
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Paint or crayons

Steps:

1. Grab your paint or crayons and the paper plate. Color or paint the white side of the paper plate (the back).



2. Then grab your white paper and your crayons or paint. Paint or color the white piece of paper until it is covered in fun colors. After you're finished, grab your scissors and cut the paper into 9 separate strips.



3. Grab your orange or yellow construction paper and cut out 9 "flames" for your candles.
4. Grab your glue and glue the flames onto the top of each candle.



5. Grab your painted paper plate and scissors (make sure plate is dry). Cut the paper plate in half down the middle. Grab your glue and glue the round edges of the plate together. This is the menorah!



6. Then grab your 9 candles and your glue. Glue each candle onto the back of the menorah. Make sure the candles are facing up.



7. You're finished! Happy Hannukah!



Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Shape identification "What shape are the candles?" "What shape is the menorah?"
- Count the number of candles and flames.
- Identify the colors on the menorah.
- Fine motor: cutting and gluing.
