

# **Happy Footprint Penguin:**



### **Materials Needed:**

- $\checkmark~$  Black, white and orange paint, markers or crayons
- ✓ Plain white paper
- ✓ Optional: googly eyes and construction paper

## **Steps for painting:**

- 1. Place a piece of plain white paper on the floor
- 2. Paint your entire foot black
- 3. Step onto the white piece of paper and hold for 5 seconds to create your penguin's body
- 4. Wash your foot and wait for your penguin body to dry
- 5. Paint black wings on each side of the body
- 6. Paint a white stomach onto the body to match the shape of a penguin
- 7. Cut out eyes and a nose from construction paper and glue on or draw them on with a marker
- 8. Optional: glue on googly eyes

## Steps for tracing:

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- 1. Place a piece of plain white paper on the floor
- 2. Get someone to help you trace the shape of your foot onto the paper with a black marker to make your penguin body



- 3. Add wings to each side of the body and color in your penguin
- 4. Cut out eyes and a nose from construction paper and glue on or draw them on with a marker
- 5. Optional: glue on googly eyes

## **Additional Skill Practice:**

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Count the number of eyes, beaks, wings, and toes are on the penguin
- Identify colors on your penguin
- Fine motor: create an icy background for the penguin to live in
