

MLK Peace Flower:

Materials Needed:

- ✓ Paper
- √ Scissors
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Colored paper (pink, light brown, dark brown, green)
- ✓ Glue

Steps:


1. Grab your pink paper, scissors and pencil.



2. Place one of your hands in the middle of the pink paper. Use your other hand to trace your hand on the paper using your pencil.



3. Grab your scissors and cut out the tracing of your hand.




4. Grab your pencil and add lines for the fingers.






5. Repeat steps 1-4 with the light brown paper and the dark brown paper. You should have 3 hands total!




6. Grab your green paper and a pencil. Your flower needs a flower stem! Create a stem by drawing a tall and thin rectangle. Then add some leaves on the sides.



7. Grab your scissors and cut out the stem and leaves. Make sure you only cut along the outside of your drawing.




8. Grab your three hands and the flower stem. Apply glue to the back of your hands and glue them to the top of your flower stem.



9. You're finished making your peace flower!





Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Shape identification "What shape is the flower stem?" "What shape are the leaves?"
- Count the number of hands, leaves, stems, etc.
- Identify the colors of each hand.
- Fine motor: cutting and tracing.
