

## **Painting with Ice:**

## **Materials Needed:**

- ✓ Ice tray
- ✓ Water based paint/ food coloring
- ✓ Popsicle stick/ tooth pick
- ✓ White paper



## **Steps for painting:**

1. Add different colors of water based paint (food coloring can be used if you don't have paint) to an empty ice tray



2. Pour Water into the tray

3. Thoroughly mix water with paint/ food coloring



4. Place tray into the freezer



5. When partially frozen, place wooden sticks upright in each section



6. Place back in freezer until ice is completely solid
