

Polar Bear Craft:



Materials Needed:

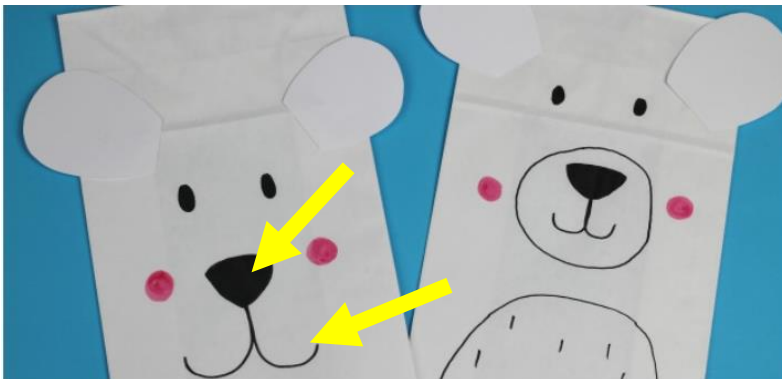
- ✓ White Paper Bag
- ✓ White paper
- ✓ Markers (black and red)
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue/tape

Steps:

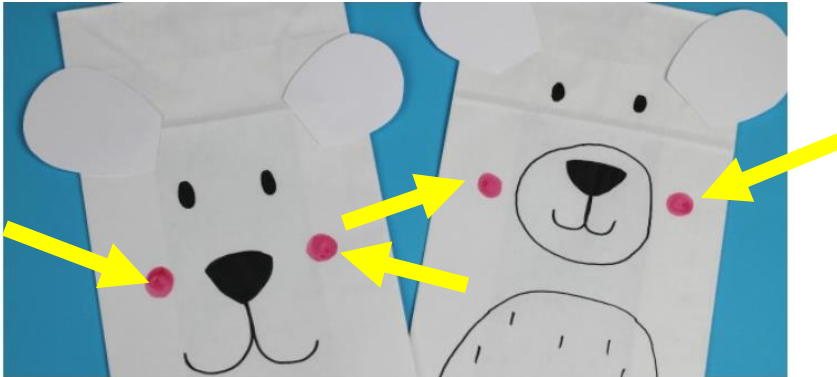
1. Grab your white paper bag and black marker. Draw two eyes for your polar by making two small ovals.



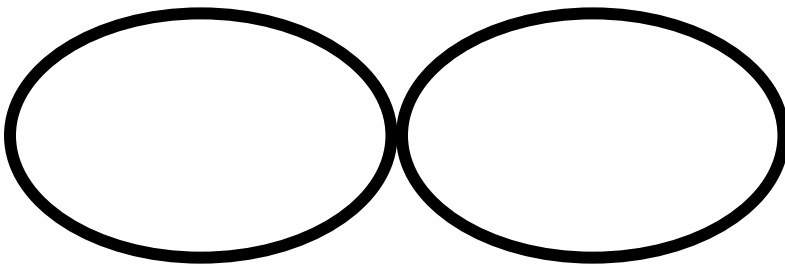
2. Using your black marker, make his nose by drawing an upside-down triangle and filling it in. Then give your bear a mouth!



3. Take your red marker and give your bear rosy cheeks by drawing red circles next to his nose.



4. Grab your white paper and scissors. Cut out two ovals for the bear's ears. Optional: trace a round object or draw two ovals first.



5. Grab your black marker and draw the bear's belly! Make a half circle and draw little lines for his hair. You're all finished!





Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Make "roaring" sounds like a bear, "What does a bear say?"
- Count the number of eyes, ears, or hair on the bear.
- Identify the colors on the bear.
- Play skills: put your hand in the paper bag and play with the bear like a puppet!
- Fine motor: cutting and drawing shapes.
