

Patriotic Flag Craft

Materials Needed:

- ✓ Paper Plate
- ✓ Crayons/Markers/Paint
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Hole punch
- ✓ Star stickers
- ✓ String / yarn
- ✓ Tissue paper



Steps:

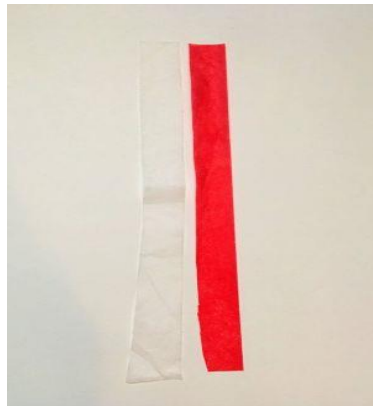
1. Take your plate and fold it in half, color it blue with paint/markers/crayons.



2. Once dry, put white stickers on the blue plate. If you don't have any, you can cut out white stars from paper and glue / tape them on instead!



3. Cut red and white tissue paper into strips. Example: I used 4 red and 3 white strips.



4. Flip the plate over and glue the strips onto the bottom of the plate



5. Using a hole punch, punch a hole in the top center of the blue plate. If you don't have a hole punch, you can use a pen/ pencil to poke a hole through the top.



6. Tie a piece of yarn / string through the hole and tie a knot so you can hang up your work!

Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Identify what shapes you see
- 1:1 Correspondence: count the number of stars you have. How many stripes are there?
- Greater than/ less than: Look up an image of an American flag. How many stars and stripes does the flag have? Which number is greater/less?
