

Toilet Paper Pup:

Materials Needed:

- ✓ Empty toilet paper or paper towel rolls
- ✓ Empty cereal box or other thin cardboard
- ✓ Paint or markers
- ✓ White or colored paper
- ✓ Glue



Steps:

1. Cover your roll with a color of your choice – you can match your family dog or pick a new type of dog
 - a. You can use paint, markers, or cover it with colored paper
2. Cut out the shape of eyes, ears and nose from black construction paper or draw them onto the roll
3. Attach the eyes, ears and nose with glue if you're not drawing them on



4. Cut out two circles and a tail shape from your thin cardboard or paper
5. Color or cover the tail and paw shapes to match your dog's body
6. Draw paw pads onto the two circles and add details to the tail



7. Glue on your paws and tail
8. Wait for it to dry and play with your new toilet paper pup!



Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- "What does the dog say?" Bark and howl like a dog
- Following directions: repeat the craft to assemble your own sled dog team
- Imaginative play/ Imitation: pretend you are on a dog team! Pick who is leader and follow what they do as you move through your home.
