

Winnie the Pooh Movement Cube:

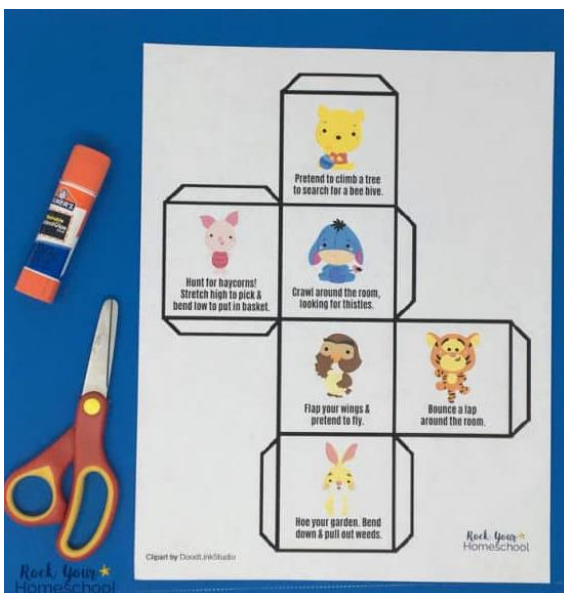


Materials Needed:

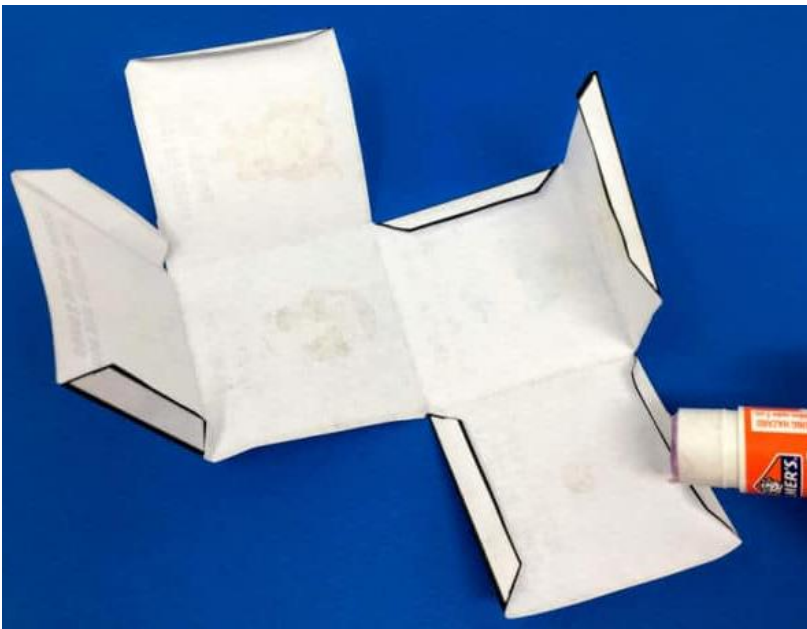
- ✓ Printed out cube template (see below)
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Tape/Glue

Steps:

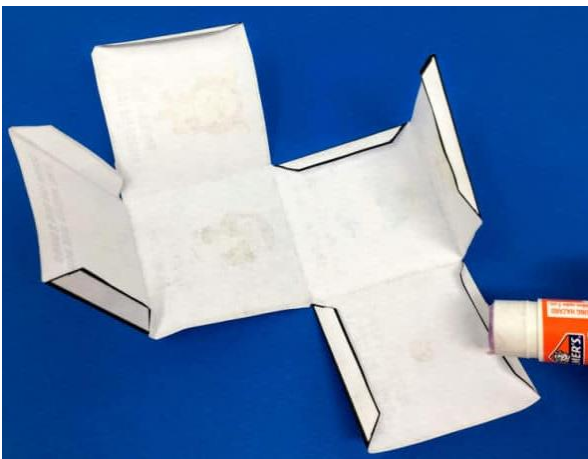
1. Print out the movement cube template located on page 4. Retrieve it from the printer.



2. Grab your scissors and cut out the cube template. Make sure to only cut along the outside black edge.
3. Fold all tabs and sides on the cube along the black lines downward (fold towards the blank side of the cube).



4. Grab your glue stick and apply glue along all tabs only (if using tape, apply tape to the tabs).



5. Fold the cube along all straight edges. Feel free to apply tape to reinforce the edges.



You're all finished! Roll the cube and see what activity you get to do! A blank cube template is attached if you'd like to write in your own activities.

Additional Skill Practice:

Here are some additional skills you can work on with your kiddo related to this craft:

- Shape identification "What 3D shape did you make?" "What other 3D shapes do you see around you?" "What other cubes do you see around you?"
- Count the number of sides, characters, etc.
- Identify the colors on each character.
- Fine motor: cutting and rolling a cube.
